U19 Womens (Anders Buvarp)

Report from Anders Buvarp:

We need players born 2001-2004. We are looking for top athletes that can be trained and are excited about representing the USA at a World Championships.

Discussions and Decisions:

Governance

It was agreed that the regional directors will be invited to a conference call on monthly basis within about a week after each USA Floorball BoD meeting, where Anders/Kim will update the team on discussions and decisions by the board, relevant for regions.

It was also agreed that all regional directors will submit a short report on their individual activities shortly before the USA Floorball BoD meeting. This report will outline regional activities in floorball development, competitive events, membership issues and/or any other topics relevant for the board. Anders/Kim will send a schedule based on the USA Floorball BoD schedule.

All parties agreed that the communication between the board and regions shall be improved in both directions and this governance is aimed at improving it.

Update on Alabama

Birmingham is the venue for The World Games in 2021 where floorball is an event. For this reason, IFF has a significant interest in making the event a major success. As practically no floorball is played in Alabama, there will be a lot of leg work required in the 1000 days ahead. Jukka Kotti outlined the initial plan for developing floorball in Alabama:

- Initial kick-off held in October 2018 with participants from interested potential floorball communities including various towns and cities, and the YMCA
- General feeling is that it is possible, although challenging, to create a floorball excitement in Alabama, with the target to have floorball played at a minimum of ten locations by the end of 2019

USA

USA Floorball Board Meeting

- Sponsorship in terms of providing equipment will be a key point; Kim to address with IFF to explore what possibilities are
- Regular meetings to be held going forward in building this new community

Communication

It was brought up that communication strategy is a challenge across the board. We need to have a multi-platform communication strategy. It was agreed to discuss in the USA Floorball BoD and revert with a plan at a future Regional Directors meeting.

Action Items

- Kim to address with IFF about sponsorship of equipment to develop floorball in Alabama
- Anders to find a regional director for North-East
- Anders to supply Kenton (and others) with regional contacts
- Anders to develop the description of "Regional Directors" together with Kim (*this was a task identified prior to the meeting*)
- Kim/Anders to discuss in the USA Floorball about communications strategy
